Welcome to the Glossodia Football Club 2010 season. The Committee would like to take this opportunity to welcome all new and returning players. Club meetings are held on the 3rd Monday of every month at the clubhouse, Woodbury Reserve at 7.30pm. Please come along and have some input into the running of the club. Our fees cover various costs including registration with NDSFA, insurance fees, administration fees to NDSFA, Referee's fees, fines, ground usage and electricity costs to Hawkesbury Sports Council, player levies as well as all equipment costs (jerseys, balls, nets, line marking costs, etc.) within our Club

Small Sided Games - Under 5 to Under 9

NDSFA is implementing an in house program for Under 5 to 7's which will include a gala day once a month – May 1st, June 5th, July 3rd and August 7th. These age groups will play 4 v 4 with 2 reserves on field size 30 x 20 metres.

Under 8 & 9's will play a "home & away" format in regional zones.

Under 8's will play 7 v 7 with 3 reserves, on field size 40 x 30 metres.

Under 9's will play 7 v 7 with 3 reserves, on field size 60 x 40 metres.

All efforts are made by the committee to accommodate requests for children to be placed in teams with friends.

Competition Games – Under 10 and above

The season will commence on 10th & 11th April and will consist of 2 rounds and top 4 play-offs. ***Please note this is the middle weekend of the school holidays.***

Teams playing Saturdays - Under 10 to Under 12 Mixed, Under 14 Girls and Under 13 to Under 16 boys.

Teams playing Sundays - Under 16 Girls, Under 17 and above.

If there are two or more teams in any age group teams may need to be graded. You will be contacted if this is applicable to your age group.

Marshals: At all matches there will be a minimum of two marshals, where possible one from either side. Their duties shall be to see that spectators, coaches and managers do not encroach on the sidelines or field of play and also to ensure that good order is maintained.

Equal time on Field: The Club's By Laws state that except for All Age Teams, every member shall play at least half a game of soccer per week, shared equally throughout the season. (Unless a player acts in a manner that requires disciplinary action by the Coach or, Club or NDSFA). If this is not the case in your team, the Committee needs to know about it so it can be addressed.

The Canteen: The canteen and BBQ are our major fundraisers throughout the season. All parents from every team are expected to do their share of canteen and BBQ duty. It is not the job of the Managers and Coaches to represent their team at the canteen and BBQ. It is not hard, does not require a lot of time and most people enjoy doing it.

Field set-up: All teams are responsible for setting up the fields ready for play. First team rostered on for the day will need to set up and the last team to pack up and put away.

Under 5,6 & 7's need placement of pug-foldaway goals which are located in the clubhouse.

Under 8 & 9's use pvc goals located in clubhouse.

Under 10's and above put up nets and corner posts located in store.

CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

PLAYERS:

Play by the rules.

Never, at any time, argue with an official.

Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials, sledging of other players and deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent or not acceptable standards and are not permitted behaviour in any sport.

Be a good sport. Applaud good play – both your team and your opponents.

Treat all participants in your sport as you would like to be treated. Do not bully.

Co-operate with your Coach and team mates.

Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please your parents or coach.

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their ability, gender, sex, cultural background or religion.

PARENTS AND SPECTATORS:

Remember that children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not to please you. Encourage children to participate, do not force them.

Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.

Encourage children to always play by the rules.

Discourage abuse of a verbal or physical nature, both on and off the playing field.

Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or for losing a competition or game.

Remember, that children learn best by example. Appreciate a good performance and skilful play by all participants.

Show respect for Coaches, officials and administrators. Without these people your child would not be participating.

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless for their gender, ability, cultural background, sex, or religious beliefs.

Do not use foul language, sledge or harass players, coaches or officials.
